Referees

2011 agreements for game reports and rules for Rochester Referee Unit were discussed. Please remember that assigner fees need to be paid on time in order to be in good standing. 2011 Mentor Program was agreed upon and the Presidents and DC's were notified. Coaches will also be notified closer to the season. 2012 will have a 3-man system for various age groups and will be communicated to those clubs. It was well received at the April meeting. 2012 fees have been changed as follows:

U10 – leave as is \$30

U12 – leave as is \$35

U14 – increase by \$5 to \$45

U16 – increase by \$5 to \$55

U19 – increase by \$5 to \$65

AR – leaves as is \$30.

These decisions were based on comparisons with other leagues.

Would we consider a fall league?

There was discussion regarding a fall league if local school districts have budget cuts to modified soccer programs. More information forthcoming after the results of local

school district budget votes on May 17. Monroe County Athletic Directors to be contacted for feedback.
